To the Editor:

On behalf of the Association of Americans Resident Overseas (AARO), I would like to express our appreciation for James Lieber's and Peter Spiro's excellent piece (April 3) calling attention to expats' taxation without representation. AARO is an international, non-partisan association with members in 36 countries that advocates issues affecting Americans overseas.

AARO has been advocating against taxation without representation for a long time and appreciates this coverage by the WSJ. Also rightfully mentioned in the article are the banking problems caused by FATCA. AARO supports significant changes to the U.S. financial reporting regime, including that bank accounts in overseas Americans' countries of residence be exempted from all reporting to the U.S.

AARO agrees with the authors that one reason for the unfair treatment is that overseas Americans' votes are diluted among 435 representatives. We believe that overseas Americans should have a non-voting delegate in the House and will soon commence a public campaign to that end. There are millions of Americans abroad - how can they have less visibility in Congress than an archipelago of 50,000 persons?
